

## Abstract

Research Title: The Research on 5th Year Interns' Research Problems in Faculty of Education, Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University

The objective of this research is to explore the problem of the 5th year interns in Faculty of Education, Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University and do the comparison of each problem by using sampling group base on interns' gender and majors. The sample group used in this research is the 5th year interns in the academic year of 2017. Samples including 205 interns who are studying in 6 majors; Bachelor of Arts in Thai, Bachelor of Arts in English, Bachelor of Mathematics, Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Early Childhood Education, Bachelor of Social Studies. The research tools adopted are questionnaire (Reliability 0.985). And the statistic which used to calculate are including; average, standard deviation, T-Test and one-way ANOVA.

The result found that (1) in holistic view; Interns faced moderate level of the research's problem. To review academic journals is considered as biggest problem for interns (2) Gender has few effects on interns' performance (Statistical significance 0.05) while female considered having this problem in higher lever when compare to male. (3) Interns who study in different major face the different problem in doing research (Reliability 0.5). In additional, when compare against each aspect, the study found that intern which studying in different major has faced different problem in all 7 dimension (Reliability 0.5) including; to identifying research problem, to reviewing related journal and document, research's innovation, research tool, collect and accumulate data, analyze the information/result and research writing and presentation
