Research Title: The Participation of Rajadhivas Temple Community in Prerventing

and Preserving the Crime Scene.

This research was a survey research aiming to study and compare the participation of Rajadhivas Temple community on crime scene preservation and protection, segmented by demographic classification. The data was randomly collected from 95 samples via a questionnaire; and was analyzed via statistical tools – percentage, mean, standard deviation, t-test, and analysis of variance.

The research results were as follows:

- 1. The participation of the community on crime scene preservation and protection overall and individual aspects were at the highest level. When considering the individual aspect, crime scene preservation was at the highest level, followed by emergency call and protection, and crime scene monitoring, respectively.
- 2. Gender, monthly income, and educational background made difference on protection and crime scene monitoring.
- 3. Age, marital status, and occupation made no differences overall on emergency call, crime scene protection, monitoring and preservation.
